

(The Swiss Cottage is about 10-15 minutes' walking distance of Shoreham-by-Sea railway Station, 5 minutes' walk from Shoreham High Street/Norfolk Bridge or 1 min. on no. 2 bus, dep. High Street 1155). Table(s) booked for 1200 – might be prudent to arrive a little previous.
