Members may recall that Lord Boyce was the Guest of honour at our Trafalgar





Lord Boyce held many of the top positions in the Service and important positions outside including Lord Warden and Admiral of the Cinque Ports and Constable of Dover Castle. As a member of the Submariners' Association Richard was in attendance.

VETERANS ID CARD

The Ministry of Defence will be launching a new Veterans ID card which will

enable public and charitable sector services to instantly recognise the service of a Veteran. This card will provide proof that a Veterans has served in HM Armed Forces in line with the Government definition of a Veteran, which is one day's service.

Currently, there is no way for existing Veterans to easily prove the fact that they have served, and the administrative burden on pro-



viders when verifying that a person is a Veteran can be considerable, both in time and cost. This card will allow you to confidentially verify that someone has served in the Armed Forces.

Most veterans over the age of 55 will probably be in receipt of a MOD pension which should cut down the need for fulfilling any other criteria.

As with the Veterans badge, eligibility is open to all Services, their Reserves and Auxiliaries.
